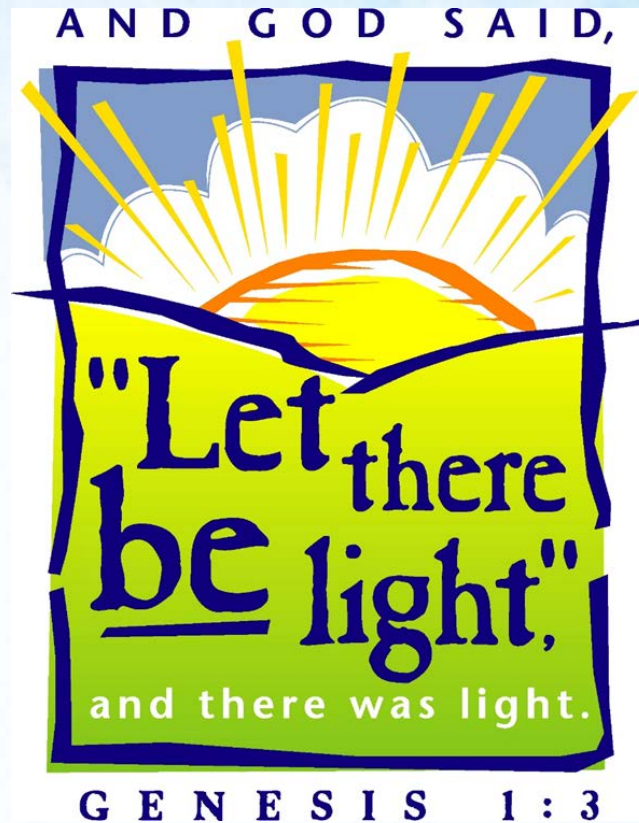

*** CONFESSION AND FORGIVENESS**

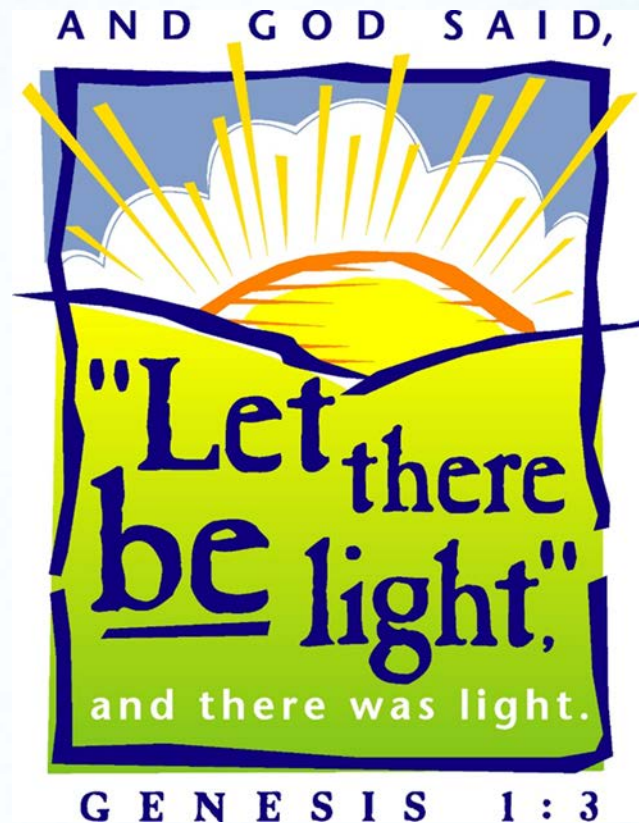

The bread may be broken for distribution.

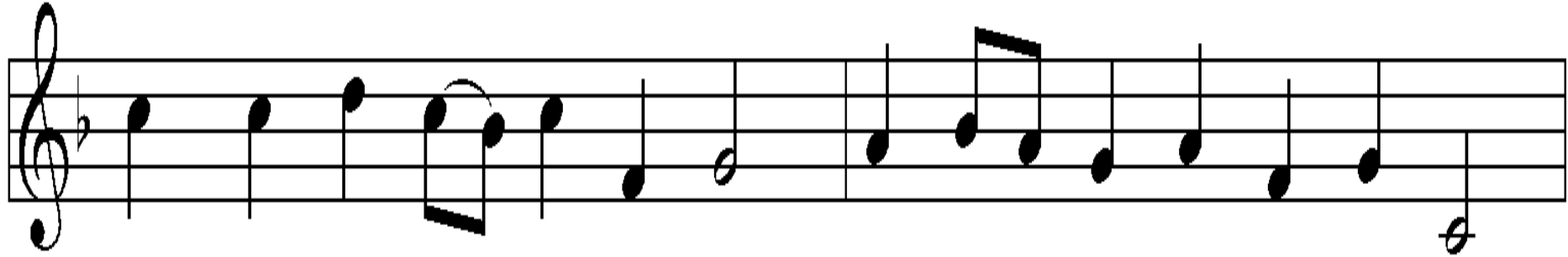
As the ministers give the bread and wine, they say these words :

* POST COMMUNION CANTACLE

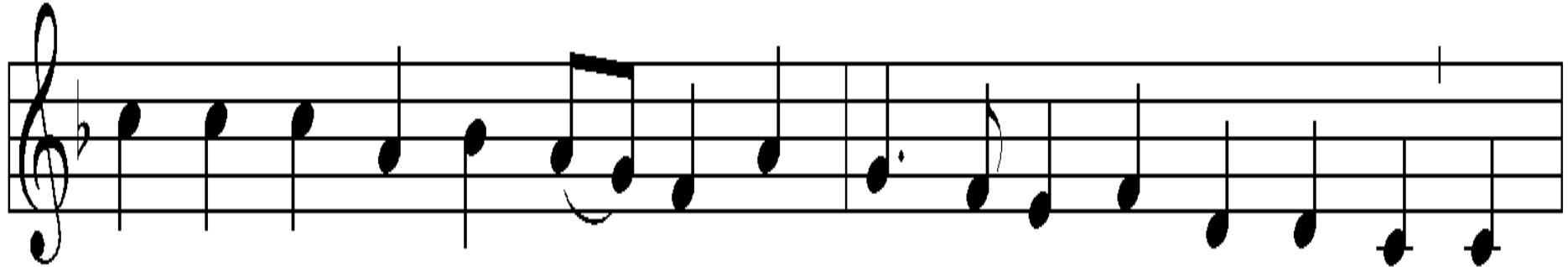

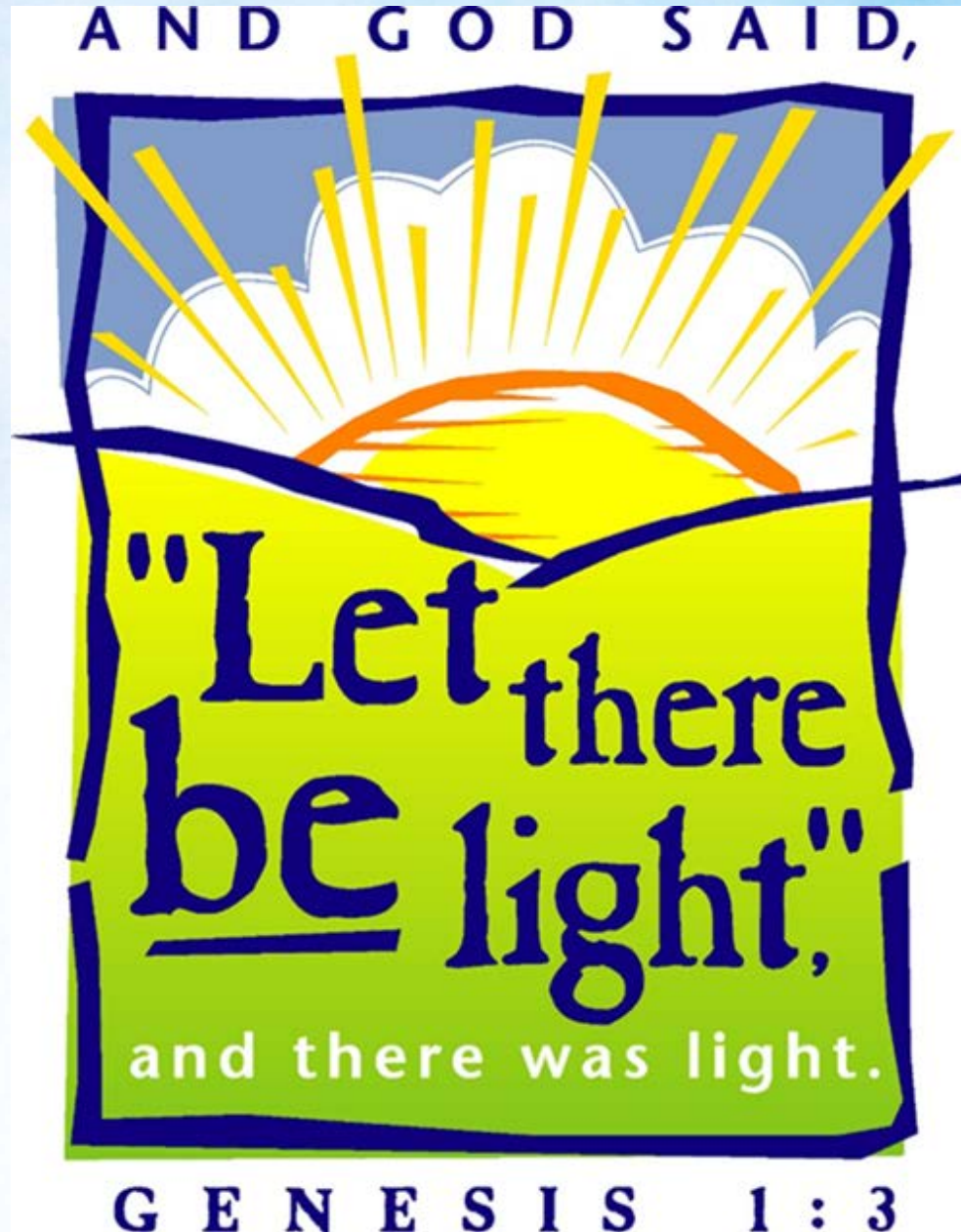

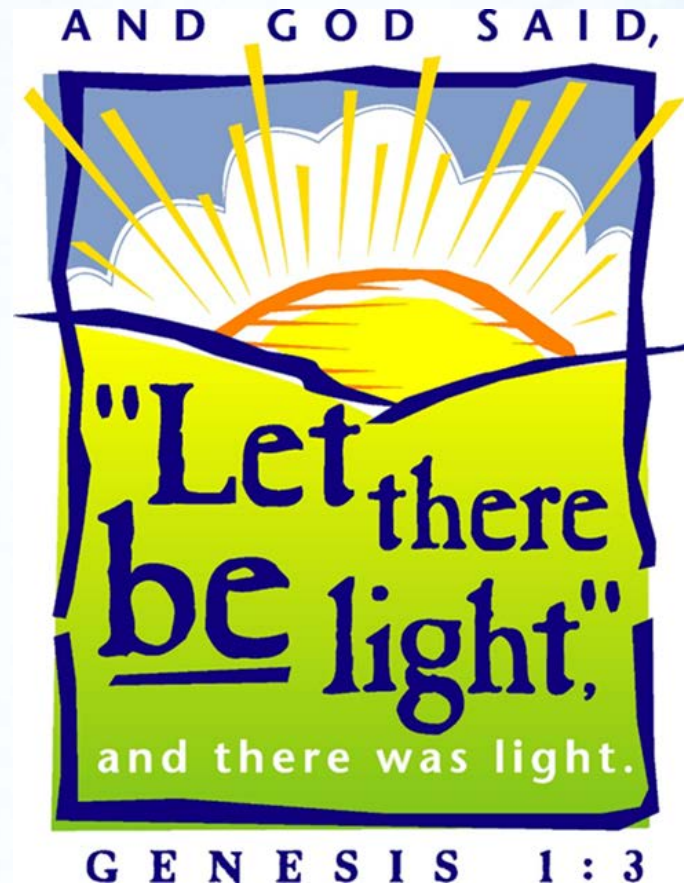
